Junior goaltender Bradley Koskie had an excellent start to his junior year in boys hockey. Bradley is a talented, quiet and hardworking player who has

come into his own this season. He is a returning All-IMAC who is in his third year as a Varsity player.

During the month of January Bradley earned a 5-1 record, with the school's first ever win over Breck, two over St. Paul Academy and Summit School, as well as wins over Minnehaha Academy and nonconference foe, River Falls. His lone loss was by a 3-2 score to fifth ranked Mound Westonka.

Bradley's overall record is 9-4-1 with 471 shots on goal, a 92% save percentage and a 2.59 goals against average.

Bradley is also an excellent baseball player and splits his seasons accordingly.

Senior captain Anna Counts has had an excellent start to her senior year in girls basketball. A very talented post player, Anna has been contributing at the varsity level since 2014. She currently is the team's leading scorer and rebounder averaging 17.7 points per game and 10.7 rebounds per game.

Her skills don't stop there though. Anna also averages 2.9 blocks per game and has 46 blocks on the season so far which puts her at third in the entire state. Anna was selected to the St. Olaf Holiday Hoops Classic All-Tournament Team where she also tied the tournament record for blocked shots.

Anna has had an incredible season anchoring the Providence Lion's defense which only gives up 44 points per game on average. She has been an excellent leader for the Lions this season and has been a vital part to the team's success.
