
Maren Overgaard and Helen Townley



The sprint relay of Maren Overgaard '26 and Helen Townley '25 had a standout season with the SPA nordic ski program. They lead the team to another IMAC Championship, finishing first in the conference meet by almost two minutes ahead of the next closest IMAC relay. They went on to clinch the section championship title with ease (more than 40 seconds before the 2nd place relay), helping the team earn a trip to the State Tournament for the third year in a row. At State, Overgaard and Townley finished second overall in the sprint relay race with a time of 16:19, and boosted the team to a 6th place finish.

Anika Golla '25 had the best season of her gymnastics career thus far. She worked hard throughout the season on new skills and perfecting her routines. Anika competed in the Breck Luau Invitational at the beginning of the month and helped the team take fourth place in a field of mainly AA teams. She finished second on Vault and in the All-Around competition. She rounded out the meet with a fifth place finish on Bars, sixth on Beam and fourth on Floor. Anika finished the season as the Section 4A Floor and All-Around Champion with personal bests on both events and helping the team to a season high score and second place finish. She outscored top contenders from Mahtomedi to qualify for the Class A State Meet. For Anika's first experience at the State Meet she did very well by finishing in 12th place in the All-Around. She also took 15th on Vault, 18th on Beam, 29th on Floor, and 22nd on Bars. Anika was also named All Section, All State and All American for her scores throughout the season.
