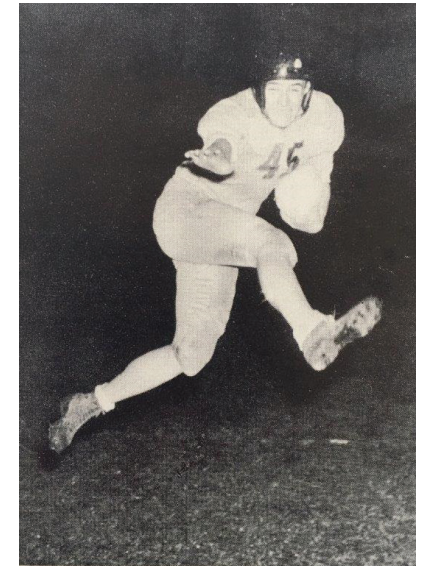
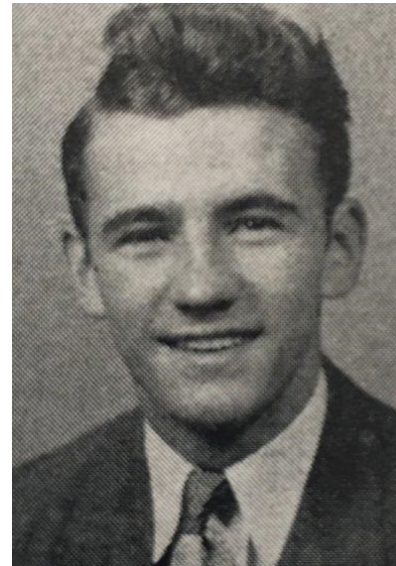

GHS Class of 1993

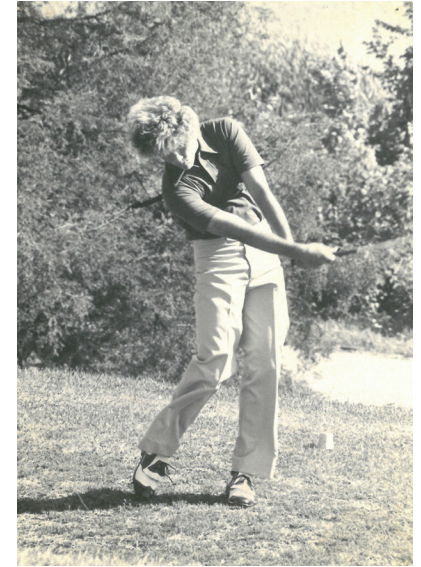
