

First Interstate Arena prohibits all bags, backpacks, and other carriers from being brought into the arena with the following exceptions:

- Clear Bags no larger than 12" x 6" x 12"
- Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5"
- One gallon clear plastic freezer bag
- Diaper Bags*
- Medically Necessary Bags**
- *All items/contents in a bag must be clearly visible and identifiable for Security. Items, décor, or pouches may not be used to obscure the visibility of other contents in a bag.*

Sports Season Guidelines: Coaches, athletes, cheerleaders, and band members will have a designated entrance and may bring duffle bags, uniforms, or instruments for events.

Spectators: No camera bags will be allowed. Cameras may be carried in, but all camera accessories must be placed in a clear plastic as described above.

Please note, the First Interstate Arena Clear Bag Policy will be enforced for all arena events including but not limited to concerts, rodeos, monster trucks, and all sporting events, unless otherwise noted.

All approved bags are subject to inspection upon entry and are subject to additional inspections within the arena.

Guests with bags or items that do not satisfy the First Interstate Arena Clear Bag Policy are encouraged to return their bags or items to their vehicle.

A bag check service is not available.

*Bags labeled as a "diaper bag" must be paired with a guardian and child, upon entry and contain diaper-changing related items, such as diapers, wipes, childcare needs, etc. Diaper bags are not subject to the 12" x 6" x 12" sizing but will be screened prior to entry.

**Medically Necessary Bag exception is only extended to bags that are specifically necessary/required for medical equipment and accommodations

that cannot fit within the standard bag policy size, such as a lunchbox with an ice pack to keep chilled medication, oxygen tank carrier/bag, a large bag to carry a lactation pump, etc.

- Medical-related items that can fit into the Clear bag sizing will not qualify for a larger medical bag exception and should be brought in a Clear bag that meets the bag requirements.

Examples of medical items that will not qualify for a Medically Necessary Bag, include but are not limited to; medication, pill bottles, epi-pens, inhalers, syringes, snacks related to diabetic needs, etc. These items should be brought in a Clear bag that meets the First Interstate Arena Clear Bag Policy.
