## HITTING THE MARK –

MOA Commissioner Mark Beckman

It is hard to believe I only have two more columns to write for the Official Word after serving eighteen years as your MOA Commissioner. The business of the MOA really hasn't changed and the items I will address will be those that are similar from previous years because of their importance to officials.

This year I was involved in the set up and worked the first day of the Class C State Basketball Tournament and then was able to head to Billings to attend (and personally watch) the Class AA tournament. Amy Bartels took over the Class C after I left and did an outstanding job managing the event! For all our state tournaments, the venues did a great job administering these events, and the crowds, for the most part, were very supportive of their teams. The officials working these tournaments did an outstanding job. Officials were in the proper uniform, including wearing appropriate footwear. As I have stated many times before, consistency in enforcing NFHS rules including mechanics and official uniform requirements, is something we need to continue to work on throughout the state, whether during regular season or during post season play. Wearing the proper MOA uniform and enforcement of rules for your sport should be from the first game officiated to the last game on your schedule. We have high expectations for coaches and players to follow the rules of the game; the same expectations should be for officials to enforce NFHS rules and adhere to MOA requirements.

In my previous April "Official Word" articles the focus has been on what we, as the MOA and as officials, can do about changing the culture of some of our fan base in relationship to their constant criticism of officials. The MOA Regional Directors continue to explore some different strategies to recruit and retain officials during these times where criticism of officials (and even of coaches and players) is more widespread. I believe this information is worth repeating and hopefully each of you will share this information with prospective officials, the media, and anyone/everyone interested in high school sports. We launched the Respect Officials Initiative seven years ago. Also, we send out Conduct Counts posters to schools to display and they have been very well received. Administrators like that the consequences for certain behavior are listed on the poster. Some officials have also referred to those posters with success.

As I wind up my career, I believe the following information should be shared regarding officials and high school sports anywhere and anytime we can:

Our close to 1600 members of the Montana Officials Association are men and women of integrity and have chosen this avocation because they have a passion for the sport(s) they officiate. They spend a significant amount of time studying and training to improve. Each week they attend and complete study clubs along with completing training regarding mechanics and rule interpretations. They are subject to local pool evaluations of their performance as they work to move up the rankings from Apprentice to Certified to Master Official. Our officials train and study to be the best officials they can.

I believe sometimes fans and others fail to remember that the MHSA and MOA deal primarily with high school sports and activities. High school sports are definitely an opportunity for students to compete, but more importantly high school sports provide educational opportunities for student-athletes. Criticizing any of the participants in a high school contest, whether a player, coach or an official, is counterproductive of the educational mission of high school sports. If the officials or coaches are scrutinized at this level for performing their duties in an avocation they do for their passion and not for the money, we will continue to lose good people from those professions, ultimately affecting the ability to provide these worthwhile opportunities for our student-athletes. **As we state in our current Respect Officials' campaign, "Without Officials, it's Just Recess".**

We need to reinforce these points every time we get the chance.

As we work to recruit and retain officials and to attempt to gain more respect and appreciation for the officiating avocation, it is important we focus not only on recruiting but especially on retention. We lose far too many officials after a couple of years. Besides fan behavior, three of the major reasons we lose officials across the country are: 1) family obligations, 2) work obligations and 3) age. There is not much we can do about aging (I know that personally) but what are some ideas you might have on how we can address 1 and 2? Also, do you have any ideas on what we can do to

address poor student section and adult fan behaviors? One suggestion is to film the crowds and use it during and/or after. We would appreciate your thoughts on these matters!

As we close the school year with spring sports, I hope you enjoy the remainder of the spring season (warm and dry weather with any luck)!

### 2022-2023 MOA REGISTRATION

Again, this year online registration is being offered via The NFHS COS through Dragonfly Athletics. Please note that to make this online process available, there will be a small convenience fee per transaction required by the service providers. This convenience fee will be automatically added to your total amount due.

2022-2023 MOA Registration will open on **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022**. Dues are outstanding after *June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022*. **June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022-June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022** all registering officials will receive a \$50 late fee and will be, required to retest with the score equivalent to the officials rating.

**Officials who register past the June 21<sup>st</sup> date will not be allowed to upgrade at any level.**

**July 1, 2022, or after**, all renewed officials will receive a \$50 late fee and will be, required to retest with the score equivalent to the officials rating. Late Officials will not be eligible for any post season contests. Masters will not lose their rating once testing is completed on time with a score equivalent to the official's rating.

**\*\*Only digital books will be available after the July 1st date for renewed officials. No physical book(s) will be mailed.**

All late requirements must be completed by the posted deadlines. No Exceptions.
