RE EXECUTIVE BOARD ACTION

The Montana High School Association Executive Board conducted a regularly scheduled meeting on September 13, 2021. Following is a synopsis of the major items:

1. The Board placed Missoula Sentinel High School on probation. The probation will extend to the end of the 2021-22 school year. The Executive Board approved the probation status based upon the violations by Sentinel High School during the past two years. A school on probation is on conditional Association membership, however Sentinel High School can still engage in its regular season schedule and post season play provided the school files a program indicating the measures they are taking and will be taking to address the issues that caused Sentinel to be placed on probation by the Board, including actions to prevent any future violations.
2. The Board reviewed reports regarding state championships held in the spring including track and field, softball, tennis, and golf. The Executive Board and MHSA staff appreciates the managers and the venue personnel that administered and hosted these extremely successful events.
3. The Board approved a traveling trophy for Class golf divisional tournaments and approved brackets for the 1C District volleyball tournament and the Eastern C divisional boys' and girls' basketball tournaments.
