



## MOA Basketball Officials Certified Camp Instructor Information Sheet

To be eligible to officiate postseason divisional and state tournaments, MOA basketball officials are required to attend an MOA Certified Basketball Officials Camp at least once every three years. This requirement will take effect for the 2027 postseason. This gives officials the opportunity to attend a camp in 2025 or 2026 to meet the 2027 postseason requirement. As an incentive, officials who attend a camp in 2025 will be credited through the 2029 postseason, giving them a one-time 4-year credit.

To support this change, the MOA needs experienced officials to become **Certified Camp Instructors** for the Certified MOA Basketball Officials Camps. The following information outlines the responsibilities, qualifications, and guidelines for those interested in applying to become a Certified Camp Instructor.

Certified MOA Basketball Officials Camps need a minimum ratio of 1 MOA certified trainer per 8 campers. More specific information related to certification of MOA officials' camps will be sent in the near future.

### Certified Camp Instructor Job Description

#### Primary Responsibilities:

- Instruction and Training:
  - Lead on-court and classroom sessions focused on 3-person basketball mechanics.
  - Demonstrate proper floor mechanics, hand mechanics, rule application, and presentation.
  - Provide real-time feedback to officials during camp games.
- Camp Logistics:
  - Assist with the overall organization and coordination of camp activities.
  - Ensure all participants are engaged and motivated throughout the camp.
  - Maintain a positive, professional environment for both trainers and campers.

#### Key Qualifications:

- Certification: Applicants should hold or have held a Master Certification with the MOA (or an equivalent certification from another state) in basketball.
- Experience: Applicants must have at least **one** of the following:
  - Worked a minimum of 3 MHSAs postseason divisional and/or state tournaments (or equivalent in another state).
  - Worked as a staff member at a minimum of 3 Basketball Officials Camps.
- Teaching Skills: Experience in instructing and developing officials at an Officials Camp is strongly preferred.
- Communication: Strong verbal and written communication skills with the ability to teach and engage officials.

- Leadership: Demonstrated ability to lead by example, provide constructive feedback, and motivate officials to improve.
