

2026 MHSA STATE SWIM MEET

Great Falls High School Pool

February 12, 13 & 14, 2026

RULES: The meet will be conducted in accordance with the 2025-2026 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules and the 2025-2026 Montana High School Association Official Handbook.

Pre-Meet Workouts: The Great Falls High School Pool will be open for assigned pre-meet workouts on Thursday, February 12, 2026. Pre-meet workouts will be scheduled in 45-minute increments. The time slots will be assigned based on the travel distance of the teams to Great Falls. Team packets will be available at the pre-meet workouts.

CHECK-IN AND COACHES MEETING: All teams are requested to check in at the Great Falls High School Pool, 1900 5th Ave North, Great Falls, MT. There will be a meeting and scratch session for head coaches and team captains on Friday, February 13, 2026, at 8:10 AM in the hospitality room at the pool. The meet manager and meet referee will discuss additional information pertaining to the meet and a jury of appeals will be selected. The appeals committee will consist of two coaches and the meet manager. The coaches will be selected by the participating teams prior to the start of preliminaries and will be impaneled for the duration of the meet. Coaches will receive a packet of meet information at this time or upon arrival for warm-ups.

STARTING TIME: Warm-ups will commence at 8:20 AM and end at 11:00 AM. Warm-up schedules for teams and guidelines are included in this document. The meet will start at 11:00 AM after warm-up and coaches' meeting.

Warm-Ups before and during the meet on Friday: On Friday warmups will start at 8:20 AM. Either the head coach or an assistant coach must be on deck while your swimmers are warming up. From 8:20 AM until 11:00 AM there will be assigned team warmups for all swimmers. During the meet the warmup pool will be open for warmups/cool down. Please note these times are subject to change with notice from the referee.

ELIGIBILITY: All high school students participating in swimming meets or tournaments must meet all MHSA eligibility requirements.

For an athlete to be eligible to compete in the State Swim Meet he/she must compete in at least two (2) Association-sanctioned meets during the regular swimming season. Only a medical waiver from a certified physician stating that an athlete has sustained an injury preventing him/her from competing until that time will be accepted as a condition to be exempted from this rule. The high school for which the student will participate must file a request with the MHSA Executive Director for consideration of a waiver of this rule.

Swimmers who compete in the State Swim Meet must have a reportable time in that event from an MHSA sanctioned meet that takes place during the current competitive season. Athletes may not use a time or event from a previous year's competition or from non-MHSA events.

ENTRIES: Each team shall be permitted a maximum of four (4) entries in an individual event and one (1) team in a relay event. A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. Preliminaries and finals are considered one meet. Being designated as a member of a relay team does not count as an entry unless the competitor actually competes in the event.

Relay entry cards are required for relays. Schools shall designate up to eight (8) swimmers per relay team on the entries. "The referee shall specify the time of submission of entries, and changes may be submitted to the referee, or the referee's designee, prior to the start of the race, after which there shall be no changes." Submit all entries on the enclosed team entry form or through Hy-Tek Team Manager by email to the Meet Registrar.

Teams should enter all their swimmers into the meet and the meet register will scratch back to the top 32 swimmers for Class AA Teams and top 16 swimmers for the Class A-B Teams in each individual event for preliminaries. Preliminary events will be seeded regardless of team class and will be swum combined by entry times. Individual events will be filled to maximum of 48 swimmers.

When Class AB or Class AA does not have enough swimmers to fill their 16 or 32 swimmers for an event, additional AB or AA swimmers from the original entries, will be used to fill lanes to ensure 48 swimmers will participate in each event at state.

REGISTRATION: A competitor officially becomes a participant in an individual event when the official entry card or form bearing the name of the event, competitor's first and last name, coach's signature (where applicable), school name, and submitted time is delivered to the meet director at the specified time and place. In relay events, eight (8) individuals may be designated, and it shall not count as an entry unless the competitor actually competes in the event.

NFHS Rule 3 Sec. 2 Art. 3

Once officially entered (unless scratched), competitors shall compete in all races, heats, and rounds of competition (excluding swim-offs and legally declared false starts) for which they qualify except when an illness or injury certified by a physician, appropriate health-care professional or the referee forces a competitor to withdraw. This applies to individual members of relay teams (not entire teams) as well as to competitors in individual events. A competitor may be reinstated by the referee in later events after illness/injury if a physician or referee verifies recuperation. Failure to compete for any reason other than injury or illness shall disqualify the competitor from any further competition in the meet.

SEEDING: Each swimmer will be seeded according to his or her officially submitted time in yards. Converted times will be accepted. **No time (NT) entries will NOT be accepted for the MHSA State Swim Meet.** All individual and relay entries must be submitted with a time. Swimmers will be seeded base on their entry time which has to be from a MHSA sanctioned meet held during the current competitive season. Athletes may not use a time or enter an event from a previous year's competition or from a non-MHSA event.

**Class AA top 32 entries in each individual event will be seeded to compete in the individual events.
Class AB top 16 entries in each individual event will be seeded to compete in the individual events.**

When Class AB or Class AA does not have enough swimmers to fill their 16 or 32 swimmers for an event, additional AB or AA swimmers from the original entries, will be used to fill lanes to ensure 48 swimmers will participate in each event at state.

EVENTS: Preliminary events will be swum by both Class AA and Class AB School competitors combined and seeded by entry time. Class AA top 12 swimmers and relays will compete in finals and consolation finals and Class A-B top 6 swimmers and relays will compete in a separate heat during finals.

All events will be marshalled to the pool through a ready room for both preliminaries and finals of the state meet.

FINALS ORDER OF HEATS: Heat 1 AB Championship Final, Heat 2 AA Consolation Final, Heat 3 AA Championship Final

DEADLINE: Entries must be received in Great Falls no later than **5:00 PM Wednesday, February 4, 2026.**

A final psych sheet will be published and sent to the coaches by 5:00 PM Friday, February 6, 2026, after which no changes to the meet entries will be allowed. Meet scratches can be made, but no changes to events or added swimmers will be allowed.

ENTRY METHOD:

- Preferred entry method is to e-mail all entries using a Hy-Tek Team Manager and e-mail all the supporting word or .pdf documents.
- If you are unable to use Team Manager submit your entries using the attached entry forms. E-mail, mail, or fax the forms by the entry due date. E-mail is preferred.
- E-mail (preferred), mail or fax a word or .pdf file of the individual entries and a separate word or .pdf file of the relay entries. Also, include a typed roster of your team including the head coach, assistant coaches, and team managers to insure correct spelling of the names. Include the name of the person submitting the entries as well as that person's e-mail address and phone number if the meet registrar has any questions regarding the entries. A confirmation e-mail will be sent acknowledging receipt of entries.

TIMING: Fully Automatic Electronic Timing and Judging by Colorado Timing System will be used with one button and two digital stopwatches on each lane as back up.

AWARDS: Twelve places shall be scored in state meet competition. AA and AB schools shall compete together: AA and AB schools will be scored separately. A maximum of six (6) trophies shall be awarded, three in each class. General Rules for Awards (6) shall be followed for the number of trophies presented. Class AA top six (6) places in all events will be awarded medals, Class AB top six (6) places in each individual event and top six (6) places in relay events will be awarded medals.

An awards ceremony will be held at the end of the meet for both individual and team awards in a predetermined area.

SCORING: The meet will be scored as follows:

Class AA:

Individual events: 16-13-12-11-10-9 7 -5-4-3-2-1

Relay events: 32-26-24-22-20-18 14-10-8-6-4-2

Class AB:

Individual events: 7 -5-4-3-2-1

Relay events: 14-10-8

RESULTS: Results will be posted in the hallway at the Pool complex during the meet. Final results will be posted on the MHSAs website.

UNIFORMS: It is required for the state meet that all swimmers on a team shall wear suits and caps of identical coloring and pattern and decent appearance, the suit stitching and piping will not be considered part of the color or pattern. Boys shall wear trunks which completely cover the buttocks and provide that the waist and leg-lines are approximately 90 parallel when viewed from the side. Girls shall wear one-piece suits which completely cover the buttocks and breasts.

MHSA Uniform Policy:

Swim Caps: To ensure team identification, all swimmers must wear school-issued swim caps. These caps may display the swimmer's name, school name, or school nickname. All swimmers representing the same school during a competition must wear matching caps in the same color, clearly identifying their team. Swimmers may wear a second cap underneath (a "double cap"), but it must be neutral in color and not distract from the team-issued cap.

Swim Suits: All swimwear must comply with NFHS Rule 3-3, Article 2, which states:

- Suits must be one-piece.
- Male swimmers must wear suits that cover the buttocks and do not extend above the waist or below the top of the kneecap.
- Female swimmers must wear suits that cover the buttocks and breasts, and do not extend beyond the shoulders, below the top of the kneecap, or cover the neck.

Suits that are school-issued or school-approved, worn as intended by the manufacturer, are considered legal regardless of color or print. "Modesty panels" and undergarments are not considered part of the official swimsuit but may be worn during competition.

NFHS Rule 3-3-Article 3 ... the uniform consists of a suit and, if worn, cap(s)

- a. The suit or cap(s) may display the school nickname, school logo, school mascot, and/or the competitor's name,
- b. Advertising or name other than permitted in 3-3-3c is prohibited.
- c. A single visible manufacturer's logo/trademark/reference, no more than 2¼ square inches with no dimension more than 2¼ inches is permitted on each item of the uniform [suit and cap(s)].
- d. One American Flag, not to exceed 2 inches by 3 inches, may be worn or occupy space on each item of uniform apparel

VALUABLES: Swimmers and schools will be responsible for the security of their own valuables and property. No area of the facility should be considered secure.

SPORTSMANSHIP: MHSA and Stockman Bank, title sponsor of the MHSA/ Stockman Bank Sportsmanship Program, would like to remind everyone that good sportsmanship will be stressed at this event. Please give the student athletes your positive encouragement and support. Booing, making derogatory remarks, taunting or intimidating officials or opponents is disrespectful, discourteous, and unacceptable. SOUVENIR SHIRTS MHSA State Swim Meet apparel will be available for purchase through NW Design in the upper-level area.

NOISE, BALLOONS, & SIGNS: Great Falls Public Schools, in conjunction with the Montana High School Association, reminds all participants and spectators that the use of artificial noise makers, including portable speakers, are prohibited during indoor Association contests. This rule applies at all times in both the locker rooms and on the pool deck.

Electronic devices will not be allowed in the pool and balcony areas without headphones. Artificial noise makers are not allowed in the facility. Helium balloons are not allowed in the building. Please use only blue masking tape (painter's tape) to hang signs.

SWIMMER SEATING: All swimmers' seating will be in the Gymnasium in designated areas. Swimmers will be marshalled to the ready room and then marshalled one heat at a time to the pool deck to swim their race and then marshalled out of the starting area. Please do not block the walkways.

SPECTATOR SEATING: Spectators will be encouraged to sit in the fieldhouse bleachers. There will be sections of seating for an event specific viewing. Fans using the "Transient Fan Seating" will be marshalled into the swimming pool balcony to watch their swimmer's events and then marshalled back to the gymnasium at the conclusion of the event. There will also be swimming pool balcony seating designated for those fans that prefer watching the meet in its entirety. For the swimming pool balcony, the south end seating will be for transient fans that will rotate on an event while the north end seating will be reserved for permanent fans. Please do not block the walkways.

BUS PARKING: Buses may drop off their teams on the south side of the field house on 5th Ave. South on February 12-14, 2026. We ask that after athletes are dropped off, buses park in the parking lot directly west of Memorial Stadium or on 4th Ave. South around the practice field. We ask that those parked across from residences do not idle their buses during the day. The lot to the west of the GFH South Campus will be reserved for spectators on Friday.
