- 2) Discuss and finalize the timing of the Booster Club Board elections: We voted that elections will be in May of each year. Nominations will take place on May 6, voting will happen on-line (Coach Nylund will manage this process), new board members and current board members will meet on May 18.

- 3) The suggested player fee payable to the Booster Club will be \$75. We decided to give an Auto Decal for those who participate. Michele will order the decals from Roger. Kathy C. is putting together a handout giving examples of what other booster clubs ask for fees and will hand it out at the May 6 meeting. Additionally, she will speak about the importance of the booster club fee to the program as well as how the \$150 school fee is distributed.

- 4) Spirit Wear orders- Are we ready for open gyms? Michele will touch base with Roger and get the orders in for our meeting on May 6. The first order will include t-shirts and tank tops. She will try to get samples of sweats and sweatshirts for the May 6 meeting.

- 5) Meet our RCHS Volleyball Head Coach- Angela Nylund
All who attended the meeting were able to ask Coach Nylund about the program.

Other topics discussed:

- 1) Open Gyms will start in April for upper classmen and after May 1 for incoming freshmen.
- 2) This summer we will have a strength and conditioning program for the players. Coach Nylund will look into having payment for two-week intervals instead of the whole summer.
- 3) We are planning on participating in the Lakewood Grass Doubles Tournament this August (Varsity & JV)
- 4) We are planning on participating in the Heritage League on Tuesdays & Thursdays in June/early July. Coach Amy will keep us updated.
- 5) This summer the coaches will host a Middle School Camp, Pre-try out Boot Camp, & a two day camp with a college coach (\$125 a player)
- 6) We will schedule a team-bonding at The Island this summer. Kathy H. can coordinate.
- 7) It was suggested that each officer locate a restaurant where we can have a fundraiser for the program. Our first one will be after an open gym in May.
- 8) We need fundraising committee heads. It was suggested that we have one parent for each home game.
- 9) The coaches would like to reinstate Gold Crown at Rock Canyon. In April they will go to the MS and talk to the 8th graders.
- 10) We will host a J.V. Tournament and the coaches need help from the booster club with concessions. It was suggested that we have a garage sale in the parking lot of the school as a fundraiser.

1. Other fundraising ideas during the off season

- A. Restaurant Fundraising: It was decided that we will do a restaurant fundraiser in March and May after an open gym. Restaurant suggestions included Nicolo's, Chickfila, and Tokyo Joe's. We need someone to research possibilities, set the dates, and advertise when we know the open gym schedule.
- B. A day at The Island for sand volleyball over spring break (3/23-3/27): Kathy Hanak will research the specific details on hosting sand play at The Island. Erin Lane will ask Colorado Juniors if they would consider donating sand court time to our program for a fundraiser. It was suggested that this activity be run in a Queen of the Court format. We will need one of the coaches to attend for liability. Both will report their findings back to the group via email asap.
- C. The Snap Booster program: Kathy Hanak will provide more information on this program via email. Michele B. will check with our baseball team on their success with this program thus far. We will consider inviting Jackie M., a snapbooster representative, to our next meeting.

2. Dispersing the lawn mower: We decided that we will email the RCHS volleyball program to let them know about the lawn mower donation. Mike Hanak will post the lawnmower on Craig's List in March, and Kathy C. will email the program concurrently. Kathy Hanak will talk to Alyson Plummer, our contact at the district, about the rules for raffles (gaming license specifics) and other fundraising opportunities used by other booster clubs in Douglas County.

3. Pairing Freshman/Sophomore parents with JV/Varsity parents: It was decided that when teams are selected in August 2015, the Big Sister/Little Sister pairings will be decided by the coaches. This pairing will also apply to the parents of each player. The JV/Varsity parents will be encouraged to contact the Freshman/Sophomore parents to assist in answering questions about the program.

4. Selecting and purchasing the 'new' jerseys: Purchasing the jerseys is on hold. It was decided that Coach Nylund should speak to Tom B. about the possibility of the school paying for the jerseys because the updating is being mandated by CHSAA. In addition, she will speak to him about replacing our failing net system.

5. Ordering spirit wear: Michele Bradbury will order tank tops and t-shirts from Roger before the pre-season meeting in mid-May. She will also ask about the possibility of window decals and stadium seats. Subsequent orders of spirit wear will be made after the initial meeting of the season.

6. The status of finding/hiring our new head coach: Coach Nylund told the group that Tom B. has been accepting applications/interviewing and will have the final decision at the beginning of March. The job posting will remain open until the job is filled.

7. A mandatory annual fee (\$50 has been suggested) for each player that goes directly to the booster account: As a group, we are looking into what other RCHS booster clubs are asking of their parents. Kathy C. asked for volunteers to look into this based on people they know participating in each sport. Kathy C. will collect the findings and put them into a document which will be shared with the volleyball parents at the pre-season team meeting in mid-May. This payment will be payable by check to the booster club.

8. Our next meeting will be on Wednesday, March 18 at 6:30. Location TBD.

Other topics discussed:

- 1) We would like to require that the team moms attend every booster club meeting during the season.
- 2) The dates for booster club meetings will be set before the season starts and distributed to parents on the first parent meeting in mid-May. Kathy C. will talk about the rationale & suggestions for team meals.
- 3) The booster club should host a "Welcome to the Volleyball Program" potluck after team selection.
- 4) We should pair with other sports to drive attendance.
- 5) We will purchase 50 King Soopers cards to be sold at the pre-season and first parent meetings. These cards are linked directly to the individual players and can be given to grandparents, friends, and other family members.
- 6) The RCHS Grass Doubles Tournament in early June needs to be on the schedule before the pre-season meeting in mid-May. Coach Hammerlund will contact Doug, who runs the grass doubles at Heritage to make sure that our date does not conflict. She will also check on borrowing the nets and getting the specifics to CHSAA. Mike H. will create the flyers.
- 7) We will elect new booster club officers, according to our bylaws, at the end of the academic year.
- 8) The UNC Tournament is on the calendar for July 16-18, 2015. We will be sending two teams.
- 9) We need to actively work on promoting the volleyball program to the middle school. Ideas discussed include: helping to reinstate the Gold Crown Program in the RC area, having the girls visit the MS in the spring to answer specific questions, inviting the MS girls to our gym for an activity, and requesting that the MS coaches email their parents about RCVB events during the season.
- 10) During the first two weeks of practice, Coach Nylund will have the girls make the posters to advertise the home games for the season. At this time they will also decide on the "themes" for each game.
- 11) It is important to build the traditions for our program.
- 12) Distribute Booster Club bylaws with the player packet in August.
