

Dave Gutzke graduated in 1976 and to this day is considered by many to be one of the best, all-around athletes from HLWW Public Schools. Playing football and basketball, and running track, Dave was a captain and received All-Conference awards for each sport. He competed in the state track meet as a junior and senior and was the Homecoming King. In 1981, Dave was named the Wright County Male Athlete of the Year.

After high school, Dave first attended the Phillips Andover Academy where he played three sports, was the New England Prep School hurdles champion, and was awarded the "Schubert Key" for excelling in athletics and exemplifying the qualities of sound character, cheerfulness, and sportsmanship. Dave went on to attend Princeton University where he played football and received All Ivy and Honorable Mention All American honors in football. Dave attended training camp with the Minnesota Vikings in 1981.

Dave worked in the financial industry on Wall Street in New York City and serves as the Senior Vice President, Wealth Management Advisor at The Private Client Reserve for U.S. Bank.
