

## HOWARD LAKE-WAVERLY-WINSTED Hall of Fame 2014 Inductee Michael Holtz



Wike is a 1966 graduate of Howard Lake High School where he played basketball, football and baseball, winning six letters, and he was also involved in the Drama Department. He spent two years in the U.S. Army. Mike volunteered with the Cub and Boy Scouts as well as a youth sports coach.

Mike was elected to the Robbinsdale City Council in 1981 where he served for 16 years. In 1997, he was elected Mayor of Robbinsdale where he also served for 16 years. During that time he was appointed to the Highway 100 Commission, and was involved in the planning of Highway 100 improvements. Other community activities Mike has been involved in include being a Board Member of the Metro Mayor's Association, on the Board of Directors of the Northwest Cable Commission, and a member of both the Junior Chamber of Commerce and the Robbinsdale Lions Club. He received the Lifetime Service Award from the Robbinsdale Chamber of Commerce in December of 2011.
