REGULAR MEETING Monday, April 11, 2022 HLWW HS Media Center

The Monday, April 11, 2022 Regular School Board meeting of the Howard Lake-Waverly-Winsted ISD #2687 was called to order at 6:04 pm. by Chairperson Heuer. After the pledge of allegiance, roll was taken with the following members present: Heuer, Koch, Bravinder, Peterson, Marketon, Scheuch and Puncochar. Also present were Superintendent Brad Sellner, Principals Jim Schimelpfenig and Jennifer Olson, and Board Secretary Marilyn Greeley.

(Item IV) Scheuch recommended approval of the agenda; Marketon seconded; passed unanimously.

(Item V) There were no questions or comments from visitors.
