Data-Based Site Goal: Proficiency (MCA)

The percentage of all students in grade 10 at HLWW High School who meet or exceed proficiency in Reading on the 2023 MCA test will increase from 46.5% in 2022 to 50% in 2023. The percentage of students in grade 10 at HLWW High School who meet or exceed proficiency in science on the 2023 MCA test will increase from 39% in 2022 to 50% in 2023. The percentage of students in grade 11 at HLWW High School who meet or exceed proficiency in Math will increase from 40% in 2022 to 50% in 2023.

Supporting Data (evidence of need):

There has been a consistent decline in MCA scores during the past three years. Staff and students at HLWW HS will work to increase scores across all three strands throughout the 2023 school year to ensure that all students meet the standards set by the State of Minnesota. Working to increase scores within these areas will positively impact students throughout their studies and preparation for post-graduation options.

As a High School we will continue to increase student, parent, and teacher "buy in" and accountability to the MCA test to ensure that our students are giving their best efforts and we are getting accurate results.

To meet our goal, the following supports will be put in place:

- Reading strategies within content in English and SS PLC
- PLC Goal for Math and Science- spiral review and bell ringers
- Interventions based on STAR scores during advisory time-identified Tuesdays
- Reading intervention- Intervention students only in that advisory period
- Leadership council and calculus students acting as small group intervention leaders- timeline TBD
- BARR program- Information requested, looking to set up a time for the Admin team to receive a presentation from BARR group to determine a plan for implementation.
- MTSS, study skills, SH and Advisory Accountability, Study Tables
- 2B Continued- Suicide Prevention & Mental Health Education & Outreach- Teen MH first aid- Earliest availability at this time is March 2023, our name has been added to the list of interested schools. We will hear back after the first of the year for a better training timeline.
