Data-Based Site Goal: Proficiency (MCA)

The percentage of all students in grades 5-8 at HLWW Middle School who meet or exceed proficiency in Reading on the 2022 MCA test will increase from 57% in 2021 to 60% in 2022.

Supporting Data (evidence of need):

Our core instruction in reading needs to get 80% of the students at the proficiency level. This will allow us to effectively meet the needs of the 20% of the students who are not proficient through tier 2 and 3 reading interventions. This has been a noble goal however it has statically proved to not be realistic at this time. Therefore the Middle School Leadership Team has chosen to utilize this year's Q-comp goal for the school improvement plan. The overall feeling was that we first must reverse the trend and get moving forward.
