Last year, Jones/Payton co-op captured the Girls Water Polo Championship title with a 13-8 victory over Whitney Young/Westinghouse, creating their first two-year winning streak. For the boys, Whitney Young/Noble-Rauner defeated Lane Tech 15-12, recapturing the Chicago Public League Boys Water Polo championship after falling to Curie in 2023.

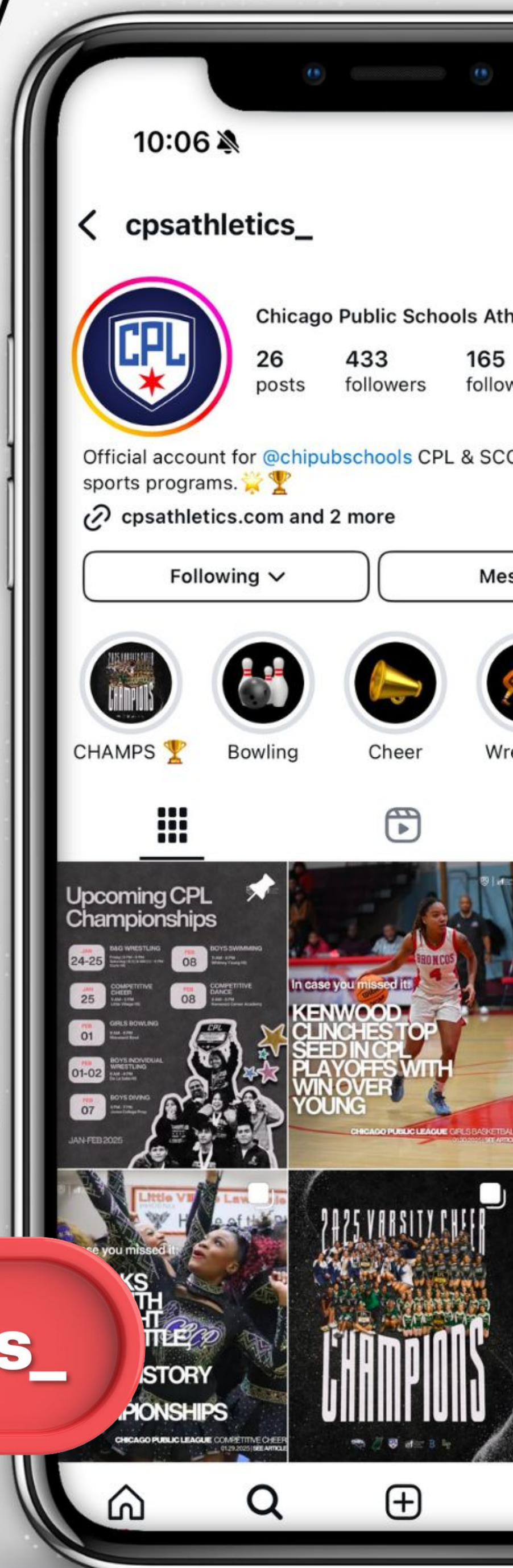

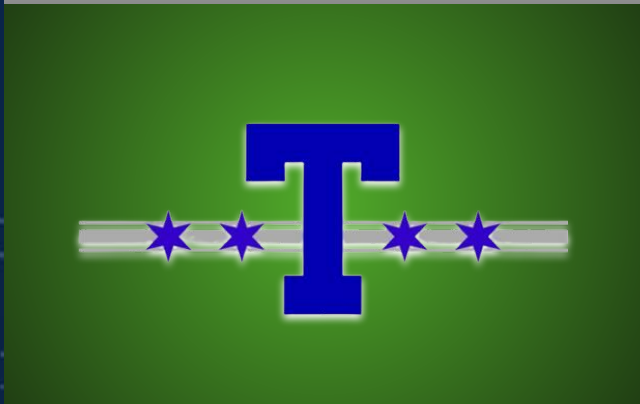
