



Community Education – Learning Academy *Behavior Expectations for Students*

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- Show respect for ourselves, others and property
- Practice safety
- Listen and follow directions
- Say and do kind things
- Respect personal space
- Have fun and enjoy learning

Minor behavior incidents that may be corrected during our program will not be reported or recorded. Behavior that requires more serious interventions must be recorded in the Student Information system.

NON-NEGOTIABLE BEHAVIORS

These behaviors may result in grounds for dismissal from the Learning Academy program. These include;

- Physical Violence
- Flagrant disrespect for others
- Leaving classroom/grounds without permission
- Profanity in words, actions and/or clothing
- Stealing and/or destroying property
- Endangerment – action which results or could result in harm to self or others
- In-subordinate – refusal to comply with staff and/or others
- Harassment/intimidation
- Possessing or using weapons, drugs or related items

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Learning Academy uses a Three Strike Policy to ensure consistency in discipline.

- Strike 1- Teacher will talk with the student to correct behaviors in the Learning Academy setting. Improvement plan is made with the student and sent home for parent to sign and return. Parent called if necessary. (Offense 1)
- Strike 2- Parent is called and behaviors of the student are discussed. (Offense 2)
- Strike 3- Student is no longer able to participate in the program. (Offense 3)

ATTENDANCE

This program is limited to the number of students that we can enroll. If your child is not going to attend weekly, we cannot hold the space for them. Attendance is mandatory if your child is in school. Phone or written communication is necessary if absent. Unexcused absences and/or low attendance can result in dismissal from the program.

DRESS CODE

For the safety and comfort of the participants, please dress your child appropriately for the weather of the day. Children will go outside and must have the appropriate clothes to participate in these activities.
