WHAT IS PBIS?

PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports.

PBIS is a school-wide approach to teaching and encouraging positive behavior. Instead of only reacting to misbehavior, PBIS helps students succeed by:

- Teaching expectations
- Recognizing positive choices
- Providing support when students need it

WHY DO WE USE PBIS?

1. To create a safe, respectful, and welcoming school for ALL students.
2. To build skills students need for success in school and life.
3. To reduce disruptions so more time is spent learning.
