



## JET SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

**Scholarships are available for high school graduates who will be attending technical or vocational training programs that are two years or less.**

Examples of eligible training programs include, *but are not limited to:*

- ✓ Trades (electrical, welding, etc.)
  - ✓ CDL (truck driving)
  - ✓ Diesel Mechanic
  - ✓ Nursing (CNA, LPN, RN)
  - ✓ Human Services
  - ✓ Addiction Studies
  - ✓ Pharmacy Technician
  - ✓ Laboratory Technician
- AND MORE!!**

**Scholarships are up to \$6,500 per academic year!**

**Plus money for books and other financial supports.**

**General AA Degrees are NOT eligible.**

### **Eligibility is for students experiencing one or more of the following:**

- Low income including eligibility for public assistance (food/cash), recipient of Medical Assistance or Minnesota Care, or free/reduced lunch
- Disability including physical, mental, learning or emotional
- Homeless
- Foster child including aged out of care, kinship guardianship, or adoption
- Offender/juvenile justice system
- Pregnant/parenting

**Intake forms for interested applicants are due ASAP, but no later than July 30.**


