## **Northome School Supply List**

**PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING YOU SEND TO SCHOOL  
WITH YOUR CHILD'S FIRST AND LAST NAME!**

**Preschool:** Backpack, waterbottle, 1 box of tissues, antibacterial wipes, tennis shoes to keep at school, plastic folder, full set of extra clothes (shirt, pants, underwear and socks). If your child still wears diapers, please send diapers/pull-up's and wipes. *Optional: ziplock baggies to share with the classroom, blanket and stuffed animal for rest time.*

### **ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES K-6 WILL NEED ONE OF EACH OF THESE ITEMS PER STUDENT:**

- 1 pair of indoor only tennis shoes that do not leave marks on the floor for gym class.
- Backpack labeled with students first and last name inside
- Reusable water bottle labeled with students first and last name
- Headphones or earbuds, must have a cord, they cannot be bluetooth/wireless
- 1 or more boxes of tissues to share with classroom
- 1 or more containers of Clorox wipes to share with classroom

### **ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR K-6:**

**Kindergarten:** 1 Pencil box, 1 zipper marker pouch, 1 box (original 12 colors) markers, 1 box (original 12 colors) colored pencils, 1 chapstick to keep at school, 5 glue sticks, dry erase markers, and 2 plastic/vinyl pocket folders.

**Grade 1:** Pencil box or pouch, 24 pack of crayons, pencils, erasers, pack of dry erase markers, package of glue sticks, school scissors and 2 plastic folders, *Optional: ziplock baggies to share with the classroom. (sandwich and/or gallon size)*

**Grade 2:** Pencil box or pouch, 24 pack of crayons, #2 pencils, washable markers, erasers, school scissors, glue sticks, pack of dry erase markers and 2 plastic folders *Optional: gallon and/or sandwich size ziplocks to share with the classroom.*

**Grade 3:** Pencil box or pouch, pencils (#2 preferred), 2 plastic folders, markers, crayons or colored pencils, scissors, glue sticks, pencil sharpener, dry erase markers and 1 notebook

**Grade 4:** Pencil box or pouch for organizing writing utensils/tools, pencils, 2 wide-ruled notebooks, crayons /colored pencils, glue sticks, 3 pocket folders, highlighters, Post It notes, scissors and dry erase markers.

**Grade 5:** Pencil box or pouch, pencil sharpener, Post It notes, #2 pencils, 2 pens, 2 glue sticks, scissors, marker pack, colored pencils, crayon pack, 5 folders, 4 notebooks, pack of pencil erasers, pack of highlighters, pack of dry erase markers with eraser, and a ruler

**Grade 6:** Post It notes, #2 pencils, 1 folder and 1 notebook in each of the following colors; yellow, green, orange, red, blue, one composition notebook (optional), highlighter, scissors (optional), crayons or colored pencils and a basic calculator

**ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES 7-12 WILL NEED TO FOLLOWING:** Wireless computer mouse, pencils and pens, highlighters, 1 notebook and folder designated for each of your classes (Math, English, FACS, Science, History, Geography, Health etc.)

**ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR SPECIFIC CLASSES:**

**MATH:**

**Geometry, Algebra II and Advanced Algebra/Trig class:** The Minnesota approved TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus calculator will be provided in class. Families may purchase one for their student, please be sure to clearly label it with a permanent marker. Smartphone apps are also available and range from Free-\$4 max.

**ENGLISH:** Two different colors of pens and notecards.

**SCIENCE:** Colored pens/pencils for note taking, glue sticks and markers/sharpies for projects. 8th grade and Chemistry/Physics students will want a calculator. Be prepared to go outdoors in all seasons.

**GYM CLASS:** Non-marking tennis shoes, gym clothes (no tank tops ex. Shorts, leggings, sweatpants, t-shirts etc.) Lock for your gym locker.

**\*\*\*ALL 7-12th grade teachers greatly appreciate donations of clorox wipes, bottles of hand sanitizer and boxes of tissues!!!**

**\*\*\*ALL STUDENTS should plan to have appropriate warm weather clothing when winter weather starts. This includes coats, hats, mittens or gloves and boots. Our PreK-6th grade students go outside everyday for recess, all year around. Our junior and senior high students may go outside at times with their classes, and should be prepared to do so.**
