2023 RED KNIGHT FOOTBALL SEASON RECAP


STEPPING

fter not winning a regular season game during the 22-23 football season, followed by two wins in the playoffs, the 23-24 BSM football team took a huge leap forward with a run to the State Quarterfinals creating lots of buzz about a program that is on the rise, while also leaving some unfinished business coming up just short of getting to, "The Bank."

The Red Knights, led by captains Eddie Wolfe, Andrew Walters, Slater Crandall and Nirvaan Yogarajah started a new schedule playing most of the powerhouse class 4A teams in the state during the regular season. In fact, at some point in the season your Red Knights played three of the final four teams (Byron, Rocori, and North Branch) playing for the State Championship losing competitive games to these long-established programs. Nirvaan Yogarajah ('24) led the state in completions with 223, was second in the state with 3,297 passing yards and #6 in the state with 28 passing TDs while rushing for 8 touchdowns on top of all the passing accolades! Returning receivers Khalif Brown ('25) and Luke Guggenberger ('25) were Nirvaan's favorite targets with Brown landing 4th in the state with 70 catches and over a thousand yards receiving while Guggenberger reeled in 12 TDs and 875 yards.

The air raid passing attack was complemented by Sean Washington's ('26) 174 carries for 1,425 yards and an amazing 8.2 yards average! None of this would have been possible without an offensive line leading the way. Grant McCombs, David Birch, Tommy Staples and Colin Alexander are all returning, and eager to protect their quarterback (just seven sacks allowed last year) and open even more running lanes for the backfield this season. The swarming defense led by Wolfe ('24), Walters ('24), Crandall ('24), and Chase Brixius ('25) gave opposing teams fits. The D-line backed up by Walters and Brixius took care of the run game while Wolfe, Crandall and the other D-backs locked down the passing game. The defense promises to be even more stifling as Brixius, multiple starters, and Will Seymour ('25) return to shut down opposing offenses.

Coach Anderson and the Red Knight Football Community are excited for you to join them as they look to repeat as Section Champions, and then take that next step to get to "The Bank," and bring home the State Championship!


COACH'S CORNER


ow many times in life have I wondered, "Did I limit myself and the possibilities of what I could be or could do?" I don't know that exact number, but I do know that it was more than once.
