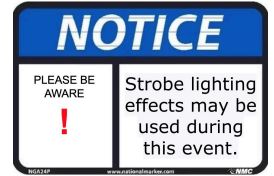

**Prom 2026 GUEST Permission Form**

Indian Trail's Prom is a JUNIOR-SENIOR Dinner-Dance. It will take place Saturday, May 2nd from 5:30pm - 10pm at Festival Hall in Racine (5 5th Street, Racine, WI). In order for this dance to be a safe, meaningful, enjoyable experience, we expect that ALL guests abide by the following rules.

**INDIAN TRAIL DANCE RULES**

- To purchase a ticket for a guest, ITHSA host students must provide this completed & signed permission form, AND a printed COPY of their guest's current high school ID or State Photo ID/Driver's License. \*ONE guest per ITHSA student\*
  - Dance guests must be at least high school age but no older than 20 on the date of the dance, and any person attending will abide by all KUSD & dance rules regardless of age. \*Graduated guests over the age of 18 must ALSO submit a Criminal Background Request online prior to 4/10/26 (See Back of this Form)
  - This form requires the approval of a dean or administrator of the guest's school (below) and that of the host student's parent/guardian.
- Completed permission forms must be turned in by host students by Monday, April 13th, 2026 with the printed COPY of their guests current high school ID or State Photo ID/Drivers License**
- AFTER eligibility is verified & approved via email, tickets can be picked up and paid for by IT Host Students between April 15th and 16th; school ID is required at time of purchase.
  - To be admitted to the dance, all guests must present their current school or State Photo ID/Driver's License and their ticket.
- Security will be checking attendees with hand held wands and metal detectors (if available) at the door and security will be in attendance for the duration of the dance.***
- Students who are suspected of being under the influence may be given a field sobriety test, barred entrance into the dance, have parents notified and face school discipline. (NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN)
  - Student behaviors that are deemed as inappropriate or unsafe by administration will result in disciplinary action which may include removal from the dance. Parents/guardians of students who engage in prohibited behaviors will be contacted and students will be sent home. If school officials are unable to contact a guardian, student violators will not be permitted to remain in the dance area, but will be held in a detention area. (NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN)
  - Guests may not wear items that display offensive symbols, inappropriate language, items that can be considered gang related, outfits that expose inappropriate amounts of skin, or dresses that are not long enough. School administration reserves the right to define inappropriate.
    - Any dance attendee who violates these rules while in attendance at the dance may be subject to disciplinary action.

**ITHSA PROM 2026 - Schedule**

- All dance guests (with their photo IDs) should arrive between 5:30 and 6:30 pm. Dinner service begins at 6:15pm
- Guests will not be allowed into the dance after 6:30 pm and guests may leave after 9:00 pm. (Parents/Guardians will be called for any students requesting to leave before 9pm) No carry in drinks/food of any kind will be allowed.
- Prom Court will be introduced at approximately 7:30pm
- Dancing will begin at approximately 7:45 pm and continue until 10:00 pm, at which time all guests will be asked to leave.

**PERMISSIONS & CONTACTS**

As an Indian Trail student, I understand that I must follow the above stated guidelines in addition to all school rules. I understand if I violate this agreement, I will be dismissed from the dance without a refund. It is my responsibility to inform my guest of the rules and expectations.
