

Mustang fans are ready to get back in the stands and cheer on their team after a memorable season a year ago. The Mustangs finished the 2021-22 regular season as Skyline Conference Co-Champs with a conference record of 14-1. They entered the Section 5AA Tournament as the #3 seed and opened with an easy 63-42 win over #14 Howard Lake-Waverly Winsted. They followed that with a 79-71 upset over #3 Rockford in a double-overtime thriller. The Mustangs played a solid first half against Minneapolis North in the Section 5AA Final but fell behind in the second half, losing 52-80. Despite the loss, they showed a ton of grit throughout the season and represented Maranatha Christian Academy well as the Section 5AA Runner-up.

Ervin Bryant is in his first season as head coach of the Mustangs and is ready to take the Mustangs on another conference title run. Bryant is a devout man of faith and a Christian educator who truly enjoys teaching young men about the game of life through the guidance of the Holy Spirit. He is highly invested in developing student-athletes to prepare them for college and ultimately achieve their life goals. As a basketball coach, Ervin Bryant has been developing a winning culture of excellence for the past 25+ years. Bryant has coached over a dozen former College Division I and NBA players throughout his career. He has also trained players in various AAU, elementary, and high school programs.

This past year, he was a varsity assistant basketball coach at Eagan High School. "Coach Bryant has excellent knowledge of the game and unmatched experience. Those traits, along with his ability to connect and care for players, make him a tremendous asset to any basketball program," said Kevin McKenzie — Eagan High School Boys Basketball Head Coach. He has also been heavily involved in the AAU circuit for many years and currently coaches in the Grassroots Sizzle program.

Prior to coming to Minnesota, Bryant coached successful programs in Chicago, Illinois as the varsity head coach at John Marshall Harlan, Paul Roberson, and Providence-St. Mel. He also started the first AAU basketball program in the Chicagoland area, Team Chicago. He has received many awards over his career, including District Coach of the Year, Region Coach of the Year, and State Coach of the Year, to name a few.

Before heading to Chicago, Bryant served as an assistant coach at the University of Louisana-Lafayette under Jesse Evans, who was the top assistant at the University of Arizona during their NCAA National Championship season in 1997. After his college
