**Superintendent Report:**

Roofing Update: The roofing project is in the finishing stages, all of ceiling tile and other impacted tiles have been removed and they have cleaned and treated the area above the tile grid

and then replaced with new ceiling tile. The custodial staff has dedicated lots of time to maintaining while also improving the Baseball and Softball fields. Ameren moved us up to the front of the line to run our new line and complete all of the work they needed. They ran into some substantial snags but were able to get it all completed as quickly as able. The resurfacing of the parking lot is being delayed until Ameren is fully done with their project. The HS hallways are complete! A big thank you to Randy for all of his time and efforts in making this happen. The only thing he has left will be the 2 stair cases between the 1st and 2nd floors and he intends to pick away at it during the fall and spring and then seal those areas at the beginning of next summer along with the HS bathrooms.

### **Principal's Report:**

We have been preparing for the beginning of the school year, and it has been nice meeting families and students that came in to register or just stop by to introduce themselves. Teachers have also been in and out of the building getting their rooms ready.

Assistant Principal Qualters has been helping coaches with new uniforms, and has already taken much pride in the Wildcats. 


