## **Superintendent Report:**

We are approved as a Lab to test students and staff as allowed under testing/quarantine rules. Christian County Public Health is our overseer and Mr. Theilen is the Lab Coordinator.

BinaxNow is our test to administer and we should soon have Shield Testing in partnership as well

Buildings and Grounds: Maintenance Grant - This is another 50/50 grant that is \$100,000 overall with \$50,000 supplied by the State. We need to project to spend at minimum \$120,000 to ensure we capture the total amount in case projects are denied and/or completed under bid.

Considerations for the grant include Cafeteria Flooring and New Backboards, Junior High Hallway Flooring, Library Flooring, Welcome Center/STEM Lab/Inner Offices Flooring, Phone System and HLS Items.

Bullying Prevention Month is October! We are looking forward to discussions and activities with our students on how to treat each other, how to help others in need, and how to promote and thrive in a positive school culture that does not allow for bullying or harassing behaviors!

## **Principal's Report:**

We have had a good start to the school year, even considering the elementary school having to be shut down for a week. Everyone has been wonderful about helping out when we are not fully staffed, and I can't thank my staff enough for all of their flexibility and hard work.

JH softball and baseball are about to wrap up, and it has been fun following their seasons and HS volleyball is currently 1-1.

JH MAP (measure of academic progress) has finished and students have been placed in RtI categories. - Elementary MAP and Aimsweb testing is taking place this week - HS Aimsweb testing is this week followed by MAP testing.

We are looking forward to getting this data so we can help students that may be struggling, and teachers can differentiate their instruction.

We are still waiting for tables and more supplies to come in for the STEM lab to get it fully up and going. The touch screen panel has been hung and some additional painting has taken place as well

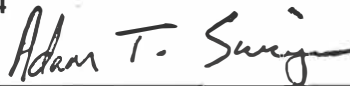
