Entry Procedures

All schools must use Hy-Tek for entering this meet. Either Hy-Tek Team Manager or TM II Lite may be used. TM II Lite may be downloaded without charge from the following site: www.besmartinc.com . Directions for use are also available on this site.

*****ANY SWIMMER ENTERED INTO MORE THAN 2 INDIVIDUAL EVENTS WILL BE SCRATCHED FROM THE MEET AND THEY WILL NO LONGER BE ELIGIBLE FOR INDIVIDUAL OR RELAY EVENTS.** PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES TO MAKE SURE EACH SWIMMER IS IN NO MORE THAN 2 INDIVIDUAL EVENTS BEFORE SUBMITTING ENTRIES.***

The Skyland Conference Meet will be USA Swimming Observed. Any swimmer whose USA Swimming ID is entered into Team Manager will have their times posted on the USA Swimming database. Do not send USA Swimming ID numbers to Brianna McKenna-put them in Team Manager before you send her your entry files. If no ID number is entered, the times will not go into the USA Swimming database.

Brianna McKenna will serve as our meet coordinator and has requested that all information be sent in email format by Friday, January 9th at 11pm. Email all Hy-Tek entry files to: bmckenna@mtsd.us. Late entries will not be accepted.

E-mail entry should include the attached zip file from Team Manager of your entries.

The Hy-Tek event files that you will need to import into the Team Manager program have been included with this information.

Correction/Scratch Procedure

Coaches will be e-mailed a confirmation of their entries by Tuesday, January 13th. Corrections to **TIMES ONLY** must be e-mailed back to Brianna McKenna by 2:00 pm on Thursday, January 15th. No time corrections will be accepted after 2:00pm. **Once entries are submitted on January 9th, you MAY NOT change any swimmer's individual events.** If a swimmer is unable to attend, you can only scratch that swimmer from their event. All scratches on the day of the meet must be submitted to the scoring table immediately upon arrival. Scratches will close at 8:00am/1:45pm. Once all scratches have been completed, the meet will be seeded. Heat sheets will be handed out at the coaches' meeting.

All entry times must be in YARDS.

All events will be timed finals with electronic timing and stopwatch back-ups.

One-way sprint lanes for starts will only be open at 8:45am/2:30pm. Swimmers must be supervised by a coach during this time.

Additional Meet Information:

Meet Helpers: All teams must provide three meet helpers on the day of the meet. Each team must provide their helpers with 3 working stopwatches. Timer assignments will be sent out via email prior to the meet. Your help is needed in providing a well-run meet.

Locker Rooms: There will be locker rooms available. The locker rooms are accessible from the pool deck, but will remain unlocked. We will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Seating: Since there is limited spectator seating, NO Swimmers are permitted in the bleachers. There is plenty of deck space as well as team seating on the deck.

Deck Privileges: Please adhere to the following deck rules.

- Only swimmers, coaches, team managers, and back up timers are permitted on the deck.
- Swimmers of the opposite gender going to support their team will not be allowed on the deck and must remain in the stands.
- No food or drinks on the deck. Only Water.

Team Entrance & Bus Drop: The entrance to the pool is in the back of the school across from the football stadium. Both teams and fans will use this entrance. All fans are to park in the back of the school. Buses should pull around to the side of the school near the softball fields (Solar Panels) while the meet is in progress to allow for fan parking.

Certificate of Insurance: The Skyland Conference will be providing the certificate of liability insurance so there is no need to send in one.

Trainer: There will be a trainer available as needed.

Snack Bar: There will be a cash snack bar open all day.

Admission Fee: Adults - \$8.00 each session / Students & Seniors (60+) - \$5.00 each session
Please note: After the morning session, the bleachers will be cleared and all spectators are expected to exit the pool area. A separate admission fee will be collected for each session...**CASH ONLY!!!!**

DIRECTIONS FOR HOW TO OPEN EVENT FILES

Each Athletic Director and/or Coach will be sent an email from Montgomery with the Event Files Attached. The attached file requires **Hy-Tek Team Manager Software**. It is unable to just "be opened" by anyone, even if you have the software. You first need to download the attachment to your computer, then open Team Manager, then go to File, Import, Meet Events.

Entry Procedure

1. All schools must use Hy-Tek for entering individuals into events.
2. All Hy-Tek entries must be submitted via email to the entry coordinator listed below.
3. Either Hy-Tek Team Manager or TM II Lite may be used. TM II Lite may be downloaded without charge from the following site: www.besmartinc.com. Directions for use are also available on this site.
4. E-mail entry should include the zip file from the Team Manager of your entries, as well as a recap of the number of individual entries and relay entries.
5. All Hy-Tek entries must be emailed to the entry coordinator by the date listed.
6. Please adhere to all due dates, we will not accept any entries after the dates listed.
7. Only updated seed times will be accepted after the Individual entry deadline date.
8. All USA Swimmers, please input your 14-character hexadecimal US Swimmer ID with your entry if you want the MOC results sent to the SWIMS database. We will no longer sign-up US Swimmers at the MOC.
