2022-23 Season

At a NYSPHSAA meeting in September, we were informed that Flag Football will be an emerging sport in the state. We can have a Spring season and Flag Football should be treated with the same guidelines of lacrosse. Three proposals will be submitted to the State committee for approval that will give more guidance on how to proceed. This overview is presented under the assumption that the proposals will be approved.

Currently, with the 8 schools back from last year, we have 10 additional schools who want to join our league this season. The sport committee met on Wednesday, October 12th and the following proposal is being submitted for County review.

Classifications

There is only one classification for flag football.

Alignment

Two conferences based on enrollment with each conference having 9 teams.

Number of Games Scheduled

Each team will play everyone in their conference once. In addition, 3-4 crossover games will be given to every team in conference 1 and 4 crossover games will be given to every team in conference 2.

Playoff Criteria

For playoffs, only games in league games will count to determine who makes the playoffs and the seeding for the playoffs. All playoff games will be played at higher seed except for the Nassau County Championship which will be played at a neutral site. Tie-Breaking for playoffs will be determined as follows:

- 1-Head-to-Head
- 2-Record against higher seeded team
- 3-Points against
- 4-Coin flip

The number of teams in the playoffs will be 10 with 5 teams from each conference qualifying.

Suggested Start and Other Important Dates

The committee unanimously feels the start date should be on March 13th.

All other dates will be forwarded to schools in a timely manner once the schedule is approved
