The achievement gap on the Reading MCAIII's between FRPL and Non-FRPL students enrolled in grades 3-8 and grade 10 by October 1st of 2021 at Red Rock Central School District will decrease from 10.8% in spring of 2016 to 6.8% by spring of 2023. In 2019, proficiency scores on the MCAIII's were 61.95% for FRPL students and 75% for Non-FRPL students making the achievement gap 13.05%. Overall proficiency reading scores for the district in 2019 was 69.4%, a decrease of 1% from last year.
