The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Education, District No. 2884, was held in the Board Room in Lamberton on Wednesday, September 20, 2023. Chairman Rogotzke called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Upon motion of Stavnes, seconded by Grant to approve the Agenda, the August 23, 2023 Board Minutes and the Treasurer's Report as presented.

Clayton Hubert expressed concern about the changes to the Art Program for 2023 – 2024 school year.

Isaac Simonson got 7th Place with a score of 46/50, Sleepy Eye on Sept 23, and State Trapshoot in Marshall on Sept 30th, National FFA Convention: November 1-4th. Leave Halloween night. 9 kids attending this year; The Fall Musical - Schoolhouse Rock, Tryouts begin this week for students in grades 7 - 12; 1^{st} Lockdown and Fire Drills were conducted and all went well.

Superintendent Lee presented the following Superintendent/K-4 Principal report: With school underway the lunch changes have been going well, the salad bar has been very popular with the lower grades and the options for lunch have been well received, only a few issues have cropped up, will take a while to work out all of the kinks; Parent Teacher Association meeting was held on September 13th.

Approximately 40-50 people attended, Shandra Weber and Stephanie Steen have met with me over the summer and we decided to reach out to the state association who answered questions about a PTA, We met again and finalized a survey which went out yesterday; The inaugural Red Rock Central Hall of Fame induction ceremony is on September 30th at the Legion, Tickets are \$20 and it's not too late, last count was around 160, Contact Brett if you want a ticket; Will attend the (MASA) Minnesota Association of School Administrators on October 9th and 10th and will report anything pertinent at the October meeting; FEMA update: have been meeting with the regional FEMA representative tomorrow regarding options that we may still have; The football game in Cottonwood vs. Nicollet on Oct. 12th is proving to be a problem, time is 4:30 and it is going to be impossible to get students bussed home and drivers back in time to attend the game, will likely need to release early that day; Mr. Barrie's construction careers class has been working on securing and enclosing the former concession stand, it will serve as an outside equipment storage area; Grades 3-6 are attending a field trip to the Jeffers Petroglyphs on Indigenous People's Day which will also cover the new requirements for that day; POC update: We have hit every milestone so far, Precast will be done within two weeks, The building will be for the most part sealed up in terms of windows, and exterior doors by December and will begin pouring the slabs and toppings on October 16th; Coaches met with questions about the WWG pairing and 38 students attend the After School Program on early out Wednesday.

Upon motion of Imker, seconded by Kuehl and unanimously carried to approve the School Nurse Work Agreement offering prorated benefits for the position.

Upon motion of Pankonin, seconded by Grant and unanimously carried to approve the Dean of Students/DOA/Transportation Work Agreement with Colby Pack.

Upon motion of Erickson, seconded by Pankonin and unanimously carried to approve the two year Master Agreement with the Red Rock Central teaching staff.

Open Discussion: School Bus Garage location; Art Program changes; Pairing Hockey with Windom; Meet and Confer meetings held three times a year; Superintendent evaluation; District property in Jeffers; Project Funding update; Sanborn City Council discussion about Softball Field; Changes to school lunch time, second options at lunch is favorable and first early out was confusing.
