Special Board Meeting of the Board of Education, District No. 2884, was held in the Board Room in Lamberton on Wednesday, November 13, 2024. Members present were: Erickson, Grant, Imker, Kuehl, Stavnes and Rogotzke. Others in attendance: Superintendent Lee and Doreen Kronback.

Chairman Stavnes called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Upon motion of Kuehl, seconded by Grant and unanimously carried to approve the Agenda for the meeting.

Member Rogotzke introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS OF VOTES OF SCHOOL DISTRICT GENERAL ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 2884 as follows:

It is hereby found, determined, and declared that the general election of the voters of the district held on November 5, 2024, was in all respects duly and legally called and held.

The ballot count is as follows:

Precinct 1 - four year term - Nate Erickson - 566 votes, 8 write-in votes;

Precinct 2 - four year term - Thomas Kuehl - 561 votes, 6 write-in votes;

Precinct 3 - four year term - Brian Werner - 373 votes, Alex Pankonin - 173 votes, 5 write-in votes;

At Large - four year term - Troy Erickson - 657 votes, John Hansen - 437 votes, Adam Kronback - 335 votes, Marissa Brown - 333 votes, 10 write-in votes;

Newly elected Board Members Nate Erickson, Thomas Kuehl, Brian Werner and Troy Erickson will take office after the first Monday in January 2025.

The school district clerk is hereby authorized to certify the results of the election to the county auditor of each county in which the school district is located in whole or in part.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded By Kuehl.

Upon roll call vote being taken theron, the following voted in favor thereof: Imker, Erickson, Rogotzke, Grant, Kuehl and Stavnes.

And the following voted against the same: None

Whereupon said resolution, having received the affirmative votes of two-thirds of the members, was declared duly passed and adopted.

Upon motion of Rogotzke, seconded by Erickson the meeting was adjourned at 5:03 p.m.
