- 2. ECFE Update Sara Wayne was unable to attend. She has been doing a lot of organizing of materials. She has held two classes fall, winter and spring. She is hosting the Week of the Young Child Carnvial, Sign Language class, and monthly family events. She will let us know soon if she will be with us again next year.
- 3. 2007-2008 Community Education Budget Looks very similar to updated 2007 budget. School readiness revenue and expenses is getting closer to even. Darla will add salary increases. A final budget will be presented when available.
- 4. Summer Recreation Staff Ryan Scheevel will be director for both Harmony and Preston Programs. We hired Jenna Trende to be assistant director. All full-time and part-time coaches have been hired. Registrations are out and coming in. We will look at incorporating Fountain next year into the program.
- 5. School Readiness/Day Care student tuition In the past our day care students that attended school readiness got a tuition price break. We reviewed the current breaks, and will offer the following discounts to our day care parents: any child attending our day care over 32 hours/week will receive \$5/month off 3/4 year old class and \$10/month for 4/5 year old class.
- 6. Granny Basketball This is a league started for older women, and Holly was wondering if it would be something of interest locally. Board members suggested doing a short survey or holding an informational meeting.
