The regular meeting of the Board of Education for Independent District #2198, Preston, Minnesota was called to order at 6:33 p.m. on the evening of Tuesday, March 24, 2015, in the Fillmore Central High School Media Center by Chairperson Kiehne. Britton moved to approve the agenda as with the following additions:

Motion seconded by Topness. Motion carried unanimously.

Love moved to approve the minutes of the February 18, 2015, regular board meeting and the February 18, 2015, special joint meeting with the Harmony City Council and Harmony Economic Development Authority. Motion seconded by Sikkink. Motion carried unanimously.

Sikkink moved to approve the monthly claims in the amount of \$708,713.17. Motion was seconded by Britton. Motion carried unanimously.

Love moved to approve the College Field Experience Agreement with Luther College for the 2015-2016 school year. Motion was seconded by Topness. Motion carried unanimously.

Topness moved to approve the Special Education Extended School Year for Summer-2015. Motion was seconded by Ellis-Onsager. Motion carried unanimously.

Britton moved to approve the purchase of the stat panels (\$8,291) and optional truss work (\$1,518) for the scoreboard at the Preston stage gym. Motion was seconded by Ellis-Onsager. Motion carried unanimously.
