Pickett moved to approve the hire of Will Nolan as 8th grade boys' basketball coach for the remainder of the season. Motion seconded by Topness. Motion carried unanimously.

Pickett moved to approve the resignation of Jodi Wagner as a SPED Para. Motion seconded by Love. Motion carried unanimously.

Bishop moved to approve the hire of Lexie Johnson as a SPED Para. Motion seconded by Topness. Motion carried unanimously.

Pickett moved to approve the resignation of Shelby Ristau as softball coach. Motion seconded by Sikkink. Motion carried unanimously.

Love moved to approve the hire of Samuel "Jake" Barfield as the Director of Maintenance. Motion seconded by Ristau. Motion carried unanimously.

Bishop moved to approve the 2nd reading of the revised policy 534 - School Meals Policy. Motion seconded by Love. Motion carried unanimously.

Pickett moved to approve the ALP Summer Program as presented (one day per week for eight weeks-June to August 2023.) Marsha Dowe-Indahl will be the teacher and a paraprofessional to be determined will be hired should enrollment in the ALP program exceed 5 students. Motion seconded by Love. Motion carried unanimously.

Sikkink moved to accept, with thanks, the generous community donations to the district from October 1, 2022-December 31, 2022 totaling \$8,194.95 as presented (*complete list of donations is on file in the district office*). Motion seconded by Bishop. Motion carried unanimously.

Pickett moved to change the time of the February, 2023, regular board meeting to 7:00 am on February 21, 2023 in the Elementary Meeting Room in Preston. Motion seconded by Topness. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was heard regarding:
