Referendum Levy Information

September 2023

The Fillmore Central Board of Education has discussed and reviewed the financial needs of the Fillmore Central School District. As a result, the Board of Education has officially approved that a special election be held. The question on the ballot will be to revoke our existing referendum revenue authorization of \$292.15 per pupil and replace it with a new authorization of \$783.86 per pupil to raise approximately \$300,000 annually for general operations of the district. 

- · Expiration of federal Covid relief funds

School District Question Revoking Existing Referendum Revenue Authorization; Approving New Authorization

The board of Independent School District No. 2198 (Fillmore Central), Minnesota has proposed to revoke the School District's existing referendum revenue authorization of \$292.15 per pupil and replace that authorization with a new authorization of \$783.86 per pupil, subject to an annual increase at the rate of inflation. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be first levied in 2023 for taxes payable in 2024 and applicable for ten (10) years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law.

Calculations are based on current law and will require revision in the event of legislative changes.

The existing levy authority includes \$292.15/student with final collection in FY 2026 and \$172.14/student with final collection in FY 2031.
