Summer Rec Programs will begin June 9th, 2025

Summer Rec programs will wrap up the week of July 28th-30th. If anything changes with these dates, we will communicate this to you as soon as we know differently.

Registration forms are due May 12th, 2025.

Registration Information:

- ❖ One registration form may be used for the entire family.
- ❖ "Thing-A-Ma-Do Thursdays" are fun activities that are planned for some Thursdays throughout June and July.

Grade and Age Information:

- ❖ Please use **CURRENT 2024-25** school grade for registering.
- ❖ Grades and ages are listed with each program on the registration form.

Fees:

- ❖ Activity fees **DO** include transportation between communities due to combined programming. Please mark on the registration form if you will be using transportation and which town you will be transporting from.
- ❖ **Check your calendars carefully because refunds will not be issued.**

Cancellations:

- ❖ Summer Rec will use the JMC Student information system for parent notification. You are responsible for the updates on this and can update your information with your parent login information at any time.
- ❖ Summer activities may be shortened or canceled due to high temperatures or rain; indoor alternatives may be provided.

Insurance:

- ❖ If you purchased the student insurance last fall, your child will be covered while participating in scheduled summer recreation activities. If not, you **must** have your own health/accident insurance coverage.

Transportation:

- ❖ The transportation bus schedule between Harmony & Preston will be handed out in May.
- ❖ ALL local transportation from Harmony will meet at either the High School (door #8), or HKLC.
- ❖ ALL local transportation from Preston will meet at the FC Elementary School, Door #21.
- ❖ Transportation is provided from area daycares. Reference your daycare provider on your registration.

Summer Food Program:

- ❖ Free meals for children 0-18 will be served at the elementary school in Preston Monday-Friday. Breakfast will be from 8:00-9:00 am and lunch from 11:00-12:00 each day. We plan to begin serving free meals on June 2nd-August 8th. There will not be any meals on Thursday, June 19th or Friday, July 4th.

IMPORTANT NOTES

As we look forward to a new season, Summer Rec is designed to provide a safe, supervised, active and fun environment for your children. We will offer a variety of activities to channel your child's energies in a positive growing experience. We want to have a lot of fun this summer, but we also have to remind our kids that they need to listen and follow directions. The staff are Coaches and need to be respected like your child's teachers during the school year.

- Payments have to be made prior to participating.
- No refunds.
- Remind your child of bus etiquette; it is the same as during the school year.
- Alcoholic beverages and tobacco are prohibited at all summer rec activities at Fillmore Central Schools and the Preston Fields.
- Be sure to read through the participant handbook with your child and help remind them throughout the season.

Coach Pitch – Boys and Girls in Current Grades 2-3

- ❖ All practices will be at the Elementary School Football Field. This activity is all about skill building. Kids will not be using a T-stand but will get a pitch from a coach. Tennis shoes or cleats are required. State on the registration form if your child is right or left handed.
