

Kindergarten, Here We Come

Immunizations

Please contact your child's primary care provider and request a copy of their immunizations.

- Immunizations **MUST** be up to date **PRIOR** to the start of Kindergarten
 - 4 doses of Dtap (1 dose after the 4th birthday)
 - 4 doses of Polio (4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 month after previous dose)
 - 2 doses of MMR
 - 3 doses of Hepatitis B
 - 2 doses of Varicella or evidence of immunity

Kindergarten physical & dental exams are **mandated** by the state of PA. A vision exam/hearing screening is NOT mandatory because vision/hearing screenings are completed at school. A referral will be sent home if your child fails the exam. Please take this referral to your child's primary care provider/eye doctor and send it back to the school nurse as soon as possible.

- Physical/Dental exam may be completed 1 year prior to the start of the school year
 - Private Dental Exam
 - SMILE program
 - Dental Screenings
- A physical/dental exam is needed for the school health file (Physical/Dental forms are included in registration packet)

Medical Emergency Information

- Please notify Mrs. Boults of any life-threatening allergies or medical conditions (asthma, seizures, peanut allergy, etc.)
- If your child has an allergy, please specify **reaction** (swelling, hives, shortness of breath, etc) and **treatment** (Benadryl, Epi-Pen, etc)
- If your child has a seizure disorder, please specify type of seizure, triggers/warning signs, routine medications, emergency medication

Medications

- Any request to administer medication to a child at school other than the already approved school medications, **MUST** be accompanied by a written doctor's order. This includes antibiotics, eye drops, over the counter medications, routine medication etc.
