What is reading fluency?

- * Reading fluency is made up of at least 3 key elements:

1. Accurate Reading
2. Conversational Rate
3. Appropriate Expression

- * Fluent reading is a defining characteristic of good readers and a great predictor of reading comprehension abilities.

- * Fluency flows smoothly like the waves of an ocean!

How can I help my child with fluency?

- * **Choose the right books**
- * Help your child choose books that he can comfortably read. In general, there should be five words or fewer that give him trouble on each page.



How to help with fluency cont.....

- * **Listen to your child read every day**

- * **Read it again**

Repeated readings improve children's fluency and comprehension.

- * **Read to your kids every day**

Model your own fluent reading as you read and reread books with your child.
