**IN A MEDICAL EMERGENCY, WHERE PERSON IS UNRESPONSIVE
AND NOT BREATHING NORMALLY, START CPR AND CALL 911**

Emergency Equipment:

AED located in Athletic Trainer's medical kit if present

Additional AED located: Mounted inside the weight room doors to the left hand side

Additional Medical Supplies: EMS will have additional medical supplies not provided by ATC

Landline located: Insert location of nearest landline

Specific address of nearest landline

Roles of First Responder:

1. Check to make sure the scene is safe
2. Immediate care of the injured
3. Activation of emergency medical services (see below for detailed communication)
 1. **Call 911**
 2. **If unresponsive and not breathing normally, begin CPR and get the AED**
 3. **Designate person to retrieve AED**
 - a. **When AED arrives, turn it on and follow**
4. Emergency equipment retrieval (ie. Splints, ice, first aid kit)
5. Designate someone to meet EMS in the parking lot
6. Scene Control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from the area.

Information that must be given to Emergency Medical Services over the phone:

1. Name
2. Detailed Location (Costigan Building) Located on the corner of N Maple & Smith Street.
3. A phone number in case of being disconnected
4. Condition of injury
5. What aid was given
6. Specific direction (venue specific) - **Emergency vehicles need to use N Maple or West St.**
7. Stay on the line until EMS arrives
