

## STUDENT INTERNET, COMPUTER AND EQUIPMENT USE AGREEMENT

We have read and agree to comply with the terms of the Independent School District No. 914, Ulen-Hitterdal Public School Internet, Computer and Equipment Usage Policy. We understand that if a student-user violates the terms of that policy or the directives of a teacher or administrator, he or she may be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion, as well as civil or criminal penalties that may be imposed by law. Access to the School District's information resources may be revoked at any time.

We understand that modern information technologies offer a wealth of resources for learning, but like any tool, may be misused. We understand that parents/guardians can request alternative activities not requiring Internet access. We agree that the benefits of access outweigh the potential risks and that the responsibility for appropriateness falls on the individual user. We agree to hold the School District harmless for any misuse of its computer systems or any information that may be accessed through the School District's information technology resources.

We understand that in order to administer its information technology resources, the School District can and will monitor use of those resources without notice to users.

## STUDENT / PARENT PLEDGE AGREEMENT

### STUDENT & PARENT PLEDGE FOR CHROMEBOOK USE

Guidelines for use both inside and outside of the school day

#### STUDENTS

- I will take good care of my Chromebook.
- I will never leave my Chromebook unattended nor will I loan my Chromebook to other individuals.
- I will know where my Chromebook is at all times.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to have my Chromebook charged and ready for each school day.
- I will use the case / cover provided by the school at all times and will keep all food & drink away from my Chromebook as those items could damage the Chromebook.
- The use of my Chromebook is for educational purposes that are appropriate and conforms to District policies.
- I will not deface my Chromebook or put any stickers, markers or labels on my Chromebook.
- I will file a police report and notify the school in the event my Chromebook is stolen, vandalized, or otherwise damaged.
- I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by personal neglect and/or intentional abuse of my Chromebook.
- I understand that I could be subject to in-school suspension, out-of-school suspension, expulsion, criminal and/or civil charges and prosecution if I am guilty of stealing or knowingly damaging another student's or teacher's Chromebook.
- I agree to return the District's Chromebook, and all power cords in excellent condition at the end of the school year.
- I will not give out my personal contact information to anyone.
- I agree to protect my reputation and privacy by not posting anything that would be unacceptable from the perspective of my teachers, administration, parents, or potential employers.
- I agree to use the internet responsibly and not be hurtful or destructive to anyone.

#### PARENTS

- I recognize that it is in part my responsibility to restrict access to controversial materials outside the school setting and I will not hold the school district responsible for any such materials acquired by my child.
- In the event harmful or illegal material is found, both the parent and the student will be held responsible.
- I will take full responsibility for my child should he / she cause any intentional damage or partake in any vandalism regarding District-owned Chromebook.
- I will be financially responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged Chromebook.
