Question #1 – Would authorize the district to issue school building bonds in an amount not to exceed \$27,590,000 for the acquisition and betterment of school sites and facilities, including but not limited to, construction to relocate 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade to the high school, additional high school facility improvements including performing arts addition and elementary facility improvements.

<u>Question #2 – Would authorize the district to issue building bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$6,400,000 for the acquisition and betterment of school sites and facilities, including but not limited to, construction of an additional gymnasium at the high school.</u>
