

Blooming Prairie Public Schools – Seizure Training and Action Plan

According to MN Statute 121A.24 – MN school districts must have a “seizure action plan” for students with a diagnosed seizure disorder.

For those students that have a diagnosed seizure disorder:

- 1) Blooming Prairie Public Schools will have on file a written individual health plan. The plan will be written by the student’s treating licensed health care provider.
- 2) The parent of the student must notify the school of the diagnosed seizure disorder.
- 3) The file of the written plan will be held in the nurse’s office (elementary or high school).
- 4) A meeting via telephone or in-person will be held with the parents and the school nurse to discuss the written plan (yearly).
- 5) The school nurse will notify the staff necessary to execute the plan (teachers, paras, coaches, etc.).
- 6) Yearly training will be provided to all staff. Training will include:
 - a. Recognition of signs & symptoms of seizures
 - b. Appropriate steps to respond to seizures
