The Buses are ready to roll.....

On Tuesday, September 4th, the school buses will be on the road again. As the school year approaches, let's keep SAFETY first and foremost on our minds.

Nor-Tran, Inc. will be calling each family with bus pick up times. If you do not receive a phone call by September 4th, letting you know the pick up time for your child(ren), please call Nor-Tran, Inc. at (218) 246-3434.

It will take a few days to establish the routes again this year. We have new families in our district and also some families who have moved away. It will help if each student can be at his/her bus stop at least 10 minutes early. If any changes need to be made in your route, you will be notified. **Parents of kindergarten students must be present at the bus stop for their child to be picked up and dropped off.**

3. If you are not called by Nor-Tran, Inc.?

If any of the above apply, please contact the school at 697-2394 TO MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS PICKED UP ON TUESDAY! If your child needs to be picked up or dropped off at a location other than your home address, please have your child bring a note to the school office and a pass will be given. For safety reasons, if your child does not have a bus pass, they will only be dropped off at their scheduled stop.

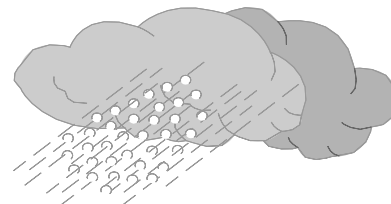

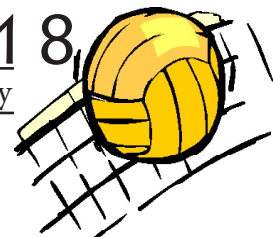
