### INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 HILL CITY, MINNESOTA

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 2, Hill City, Minnesota, was called to order by Chairman, Tom Fasteland at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, July 29, 2013.

Roll Call showed the following members present: Tom Fasteland, Martha Lentz, Jessica Lathrop, Brent Welk, and Mark Meyer. Board Members absent: Sue Kaslow. Also present was Superintendent/Principal Dean Yocum, Business Manager Ellie Hill, and Maintenance Supervisor Eric Hill.

- 1. Approved the Agenda with additions.
- 2. Approved the following:
  - \*Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 24, 2013;
  - \*June 2013 bills presented for payment;
  - \*Current bills through 07/09/13;
  - \*Investments and wire transfers;
  - \*Reviewed the Activity Fund Statement;
  - \*Reviewed Cash Receipts including donations.
- 3. No comments or requests from visitors.
- 4. There was no report from the School Attorney.
- 5. There was discussion on request from Ginny Dorn (out of district) to provide morning transportation from her daycare. The bus currently goes there in the afternoon. The district will provide morning bus pick up at Ginny Dorn's Daycare, to be reviewed periodically, and a letter will be sent to the daycare.
- 6. Student Council: none to report.
- 7. System Accountability Committee: no meeting.
- 8. School and Community Health Committee: no meeting.
- 9. Negotiations Committee: no meeting.
- 10. Community Education: Starting to prepare for fall programs. Kids Plus will be allowed to keep aproximately \$3000 carryover until January 2014. May do a small request to Northland Foundation in the fall.
- 11. Maintenance Supervisor Report: Getting ready for school with refinishing the gym floors and getting the football field ready.
- 12. Superintendent/Principal's Report: No IASC update.
- 13. School Classification: previously grades K-6 and grades 7-12, but was reclassified on June 30 to three schools: K-4, 5-8, and 9-12. Better for testing data reports.
- 14. Palisade update: there were only two families at first, now fourteen students have enrolled. No increase in staffing, all contingent on student numbers.
- 15. Approved running a Palisade bus route, contingent on student numbers.
- 16. Accepted the quotation from Lakes Gas Company for propane for the 2013-2014 school year in the amount of \$1.07 per gallon.

- 17. Accepted the quotation from Waste Management for garbage hauling for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 18. Accepted the quotation from Pan-O-Gold Baking Co. for Bread products for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 19. Accepted the quotation from Mike's Bobcat Service, Inc. for snowplowing services for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 20. Accepted the bid from Franklin Foods for milk products for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 21. Approved hiring Tanya Grimsbo as 63% time school nurse for the 2013-2014 school year with salary to be negotiated.
- 22. Approved hiring Jessie Ahonen as 50% time Athletic Director for the 2013-2014 school year with a salary to be set according to the HCUE Master Agreement.
- 23. Designated Grand Rapids Herald Review as the official district publication, with a summary of minutes published in the District Newsletter each month.
- 24. Set the salary for athletic ticket takers for the 2013-2014 school year at \$25.00 per night.
- 25. Approved MSBA dues for the 2013-2014 school year.
- 26. Set lunch and breakfast prices for the 2013-2014 school year as follows: Breakfasts: K-5 \$1.35; Gr 6-12 \$1.45; Reduced \$0.00; Adult \$1.85; and Extra serving breakfast \$1.00; Lunches: K-5 \$1.90; Gr 6-12 \$2.10; Reduced \$.40; Adult \$3.45; Milk \$.55; Extra serving lunch \$1.50; Kindergarten Milk \$20.00/year.
- 27. Approved to post and hire an Early Start Paraprofessional for approximately 788 hours for the 2013-2014 school year with a salary to be set according to grant.
- 28. Approved IASC Telepresence Classes Profesional Service Agreement with Nashwauk-Keewatin ISD#319 for .17 FTE Spanish.
- 29. No Board Members will be attending the MSBA Seminar in August.
- 30. The #300 levy can be watched on the MSBA member services website. The Board will need to pass resolution by end of September if going to proceed (approximately 67% to be reimbursed by State).
- 31. Set Board Workshop for August 15, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. to discuss levy options.
- 32. Board is considering a public meeting for September 11 with a presentation on September 8 from 4-7 p.m. at National Night Out.
- 33. National Night Out is September 8 from 4-7 p.m.
- 34. Meeting adjourned at 8:18 p.m.

On Tuesday, September 3rd, the school buses will be on the road again. As the school year approaches, let's keep SAFETY first and foremost on our minds.



It will take a few days to establish the routes again this year. We have new families in our district and also some families who have moved away. It will help if each student can be at his/her bus stop at least 10 minutes early. If any changes need to be made in your route, you will be notified. **Parents of kindergarten students must be present at the bus stop for their child to be picked up and dropped off.**

For safety reasons, if your child does not have a bus pass, they will only be dropped off at their scheduled stop.



#### What is Early Childhood Screening?

Early Childhood Screening is a simple, careful check regarding:

\*Height/Weight \*Immunizations

\*Speech/Language \*Vision

\*Health History \*Motor Skills

\*General Development \*Nutrition

\*Parent Summary \*Hearing

This screening is required by law for kindergarten entrance in Minnesota public schools. The purpose of this screening is to identify any health or developmental needs your child may have. Children may be screened between the ages of 3 and 5, however early screening is encouraged to best meet the needs of your child. The school district is reimbursed part of the cost of screening by the state and reimbursement rate is higher the younger the age of the child.





State law requires all auto insurance providers to reduce premiums by 10% for policyholders who are 55 or older, when a certificate of class completion is provided to them. If you have never taken the class before, you need to take the initial 8-hour class first, and then every three years the 4-hour refresher is taken. No tests are given. All participants will be issued a certificate at the end of the class. You must have a valid driver's license with you at the beginning of the class so that a certificate can be issued. 
