Annual Integrated Pest Management Pesticide Notification

All Minnesota schools are required to inform parents/guardians and school employees that they may request to be notified prior to pesticide application on school property. Pesticides include chemicals which are used to control insects, weeds, rodents or other pests as defined by the law (M.S. 123B.575. Subd 9).

In order to provide the required information, schools must maintain a list of parents/guardians and school employees who request notification. Schools must also provide information about individual pesticide applications upon request, including the name of the pesticide product, and the time and location of the planned application. An estimated schedule of pesticide applications is available for review or copying to the District office.

State law also requires that you be told that the long term health effects on children from the application of such pesticides or the class of chemicals to which they belong may not be fully understood.

Hill City School sometimes applies a broadleaf herbicide. This is the same herbicide used by our local family community to treat their fields.

The lawns and athletic fields may receive one application between May 1st and June 15th in the spring, weather permitting, with a second possible application between July 15th and August 15th when needed.

LEAD-IN-WATER ANNUAL NOTICE

Minnesota Statute 121A.335 requires public school buildings serving prekindergarten through grade 12 to test for lead in Hill City Public School water every 5 years. This statute also requires school districts to make the results of the testing available to the public for review and to notify parents of the availability of the information. Notification may be accomplished by publishing a statement in the "Back to School" newsletter or publication that is available to staff, student, parents and the public. Hill City Public School will post this information on the school website as well.

Hill City Public School is committed to providing a safe working and learning environment for employees and students. The district has developed a lead in water management plan and testing program that complies with Minnesota Statute 121A.335, as well as recommendations from the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Lead Contamination Control Act (LCCA) of 1988 and the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), and Minnesota Department of Education (MDE).
