The Area Adult Learning Cooperative (AALC) is a consortium of Adult Basic Education. The AALC provides educational opportunities for people who are 17 years and older and not enrolled in a school. The classes offered are all offered free of charge.

The AALC offers the following academic services:

*ABE (Adult Basic Education): Brush up on reading or academic, vocational or computer skills.

*GED (General Educational Development) - Prepare for the GED examinations, which consist of 4 tests: Social Studies, Science, Reasoning Through Language arts and Mathematical Reasoning.

*ESL/ELL (English as a Second Language/English Language Learners): Learn to speak, read, and write in English and/or become citizens of the United States.

*High School Diploma: Work at your own pace to earn your high school diploma (Also called Credit Recovery Diploma).

*State Standard Adult High School Diploma: Earn a state issued competency based, rather than credit based, diploma.
