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### Old Business:

- No old business was discussed.

### New Business:

#### Pool Project Update:

- All pool project proposals will be rejected due to high costs.
- The project will be split into two parts: bracing and sand.
- Estimated cost for the revised project is \$30,000, saving \$15,000-\$17,000.
- Bob Pichelmann and Luke are emptying the pool area and preparing for cement installation.
- Potential uses for the pool area include athletics, community activities, and protecting the main gym.
- Financial benefits of not having the pool include a \$72,000 loss in fiscal 24 and reduced liability.

#### Health and Safety Report:

- Lead and water testing is ongoing, with some lines and fountains needing replacement.
- New lead level standards require updates and yearly reporting.
- A new drinking fountain location was discussed.
- Cleanliness concerns in the meat processing room were addressed, emphasizing proper cleaning and locking mechanisms.

#### Inspections and Asbestos Testing:

- Playground inspection revealed minor issues to be addressed.

- Third-year asbestos inspections are complete, with some samples taken and others inaccessible.
- Mock OSHA inspections will be done by Tim and reported on at the next meeting

**Christmas Lights and Emergency Exit Concerns:**

- Rules for Christmas lights, including UL listings, were discussed.
- An alarm for an emergency exit door by the kitchen was requested.
- Crisis plan updates and updating current contact information were emphasized.
- Funding for classroom emergency kits was discussed.

**Other Business:**

- A window in the shop will be fixed to prevent students from crawling out.
- Gas manifold system and camera refocusing were discussed.
- HVAC adjustments and individual unit management were addressed.
- Norovirus prevention and proper sanitization were emphasized.
