203.2 - Order of the Regular School Board Meeting

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

III. ORDER

A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:

1. Salute to the flag.
2. Call to order.
3. Approval of agenda.
4. Visitor/Guest Comments.
5. Consent agenda.
6. Approval of prior meeting minutes.
7. Presentation of additional bills for payment.
8. Personnel matters.
9. Old/Unfinished business.
10. New/Other business.
11. Principals' reports
12. Superintendent's report
13. Other reports
14. Informational items.
15. Adjournment

B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.

C. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
