## 203.2 - Order of the Regular School Board Meeting

### I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings.

### II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

### III. ORDER

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
  - 1. Salute to the flag.
  - 2. Call to order.
  - 3. Approval of agenda.
  - 4. Visitor/Guest Comments.
  - 5. Consent agenda.
  - 6. Approval of prior meeting minutes.
  - 7. Presentation of additional bills for payment.
  - 8. Personnel matters.
  - 9. Old/Unfinished business.
  - 10. New/Other business.
  - 11. Principals' reports
  - 12. Superintendent's report
  - 13. Other reports
  - 14. Informational items.
  - 15. Adjournment
- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.
- C. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
