The mission of Sibley East Community Education is to involve all citizens of all ages in accessible, affordable and inclusive opportunities for community involvement, learning, and recreation. Please make note of registration <u>deadlines</u>. While all Community Ed classes are inclusive, there are some that have maximum numbers due to safety and space.

Preschool Screening – What is that?

Early childhood screening is a screening that is required through the state of MN to enter Kindergarten. Sibley East School staff and other agencies coordinate to developmentally screen your children as well as perform hearing, vision, height, weight assessments and review immunizations. This screener will assure that your child is ready for kindergarten and that they are developmentally growing as they should be.

If you have a child that is 3, 4 or 5 and has not been screened, please call the school at 237-5521 to get them on a list to be screened. If you have any questions please call the number listed above, or contact Jen Strack at 507-237-3367.

PRESCHOOL — Discovery (3 years) & PALS (4-5 years)

Sibley East offers two preschool programs, Discovery and PALS (kindergarten readiness). Discovery students attend two or three half-days a week throughout the school year while PALS students attend 5 half-days per week!

All classes are taught by MN state licensed early childhood teachers. Tuition for preschool is paid monthly and is a flat fee.

The program is affordable for anyone regardless of their income level.

Scholarships are available for the preschool programs.

To qualify for PALS a child must be 4 years old by September 1, 2025. To qualify for Disovery, a child must be 3 by September 1, 2025.


