

Preschool Screening – What is that?

Early childhood screening is a screening that is required through the state of MN to enter Kindergarten. Sibley East School staff and other agencies coordinate to developmentally screen your children as well as perform hearing, vision, height, weight assessments and review immunizations. This screener will assure that your child is ready for kindergarten and that they are developmentally growing as they should be.

PRESCHOOL — Discovery (3 years) & PALS (4-5 years)

Sibley East offers two preschool programs, Discovery and PALS (kindergarten readiness). Discovery students attend two half-days a week or 3 half-days a week, while PALS students attend 5 days per week, half-days, throughout the school year

Preschool students also have the option to attend **Wolverine Cub Care** which is our before and after preschool program open from 6:00am-6:00pm. Space is limited!

All classes are taught by MN state licensed early childhood teachers. Tuition for Discovery is paid monthly and is a flat fee. Tuition for PALS is paid monthly and also a flat fee per month.

The program is affordable for anyone regardless of their income level. Scholarships and VPK are available for the preschool programs and we accept the Child Care Assistance Program for students enrolled in the Wolverine Cub Care program.

To qualify for PALS a child must be 4 years old by September 1, 2026. Sorry, no exceptions!!

We would strongly advise that all children be potty trained before the start of class. Optional busing is available through Sibley-East (4.0) transportation for an additional cost. Transportation requests can be made at registration or with the transportation department afterwards.




