Families are asked to complete an application for Educational Benefits. If families qualify, they will be eligible for discounts on Technology Fees, Activity Fees, etc. Additionally, for every family that qualifies, the District will receive funding that is directly used to provide increased academic support for children in all of our schools. If you would like help in filling out the application, please contact the counselor or social worker at your child's school.

This year, Olmsted County Public Health will be providing an Immunization Clinic at Bonner Elementary during Meet the Teacher on September 5 and September 6. The clinic is open to all students through Grade 12. Also, we will have free child car seat checks for any families who are interested!

We are excited to announce a partnership with Olmsted County Public Health this year to provide the My Backyard Project. On the third Wednesday of each month through December, we will have a multitude of services available at the Community Center at Northridge Place/Southern Hills and the Civic Center in Stewartville. These services are available to all residents of Olmsted County. If we have enough families participating in this opportunity, the dates will be extended into 2024.
